Excel Global is still a small and humble organization, but is led by a great and powerful God that can do major things with willing vessels. We cannot put a value on your prayers, love, and support. God was able to take a year like 2020 and allow it to be the year hundreds turned to Christ. Yes, the year 2020 will be the best year of their lives.

The need for medical and dental care was so great in several municipalities that we received many invitations to bring in medical and dental brigades. Even with the fear of Covid19, we were able to deploy nine dentists, three doctors, and multiple nurses.

One of the most exciting parts for me was watching our team grow in Christ. We traveled with many young disciples that are now sharing the gospel with their own people. These medical and dental clinics give us the opportunity to teach so many people how to share the gospel, allowing the Word of God to pierce the hearts the lost. We can only thank you for funding these brigades. Our average cost was \$1600.00 per brigade.

We know we have much work to do to help these kids. God has already shown us that this team of doctors, dentists, nurses, and evangelists, are ready to go. There is no shortage of work to do in this country. We are thankful to have four new invitations from municipality mayors,we have 20 schools that we hope to start with an average of 30 students per school. An 11th grade class of 30 students cost us \$3000.00 per year. I pray that you will choose to support these efforts.
